MATHS

We will be learning about decimals. We will learn about tenths and hundredths. We will learn how to count, order and record the decimals in different ways. We will begin to see the equivalence between tenths and hundredths and will be able to compare and order the numbers. We will also link tenths and hundredths with dividing by 10 and 100.

ENGLISH

Reading - We will examine a variety of texts to expand our vocabulary, retrieve information and develop our inference.

Writing - We will be writing a fable based on the story of the hare and the Tortoise. We will be learning about direct speech and expanded noun phrases. We will also be writing discussion texts in a courtroom format. These will be based on well-known traditional tales

At home Children must continue to read every day and learn the year four spellings that are home each week.



SCIENCE

We will be learning about the impact that humans have on the environment. We learn about the impact of litter in our school. We will investigate how a variety of materials change over a period of time. We will also learn how microplastics get into the food chain.



HISTORY

We will be learning about the archaeological evidence of Roman life in Leicester. We will also learn about transportation as a system of punishment. We will investigate the life of "Peppermint Billy," who was deported from Leicester to Transylvania for the crimes that he was found guilty of committing.
