Our learning this term...

- Height and length
- Numbers to 40 – counting fwds/bwds 1 more/less
- Addition and subtraction word problems to 20.
- Multiplication as adding equal groups $2+2+2=6$.

At home...

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- Keep practising addition and subtraction to 20 & number bonds to 10 e.g. $9+1$ $8+2$ $7+3$.
 - Challenge: number bonds to 20 e.g. $19+1$ $10+10$

ENGLISH



We will be writing a non-chronological report on farm animals and a Rags to Riches fiction story based on our model text The Ugly Duckling. We will continue to develop grammar knowledge by focusing on question marks, plural nouns and how to use 'and' to extend sentences. In reading, we will read a variety of texts to apply our phonic knowledge and build on developing independent reading skills. In shared reading, we will focus on word reading and comprehension.
