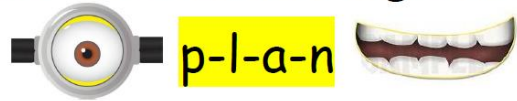


What *strategies* do good readers use?

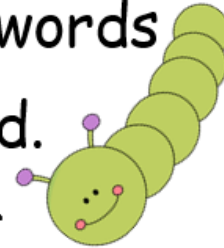
Look at the letters,

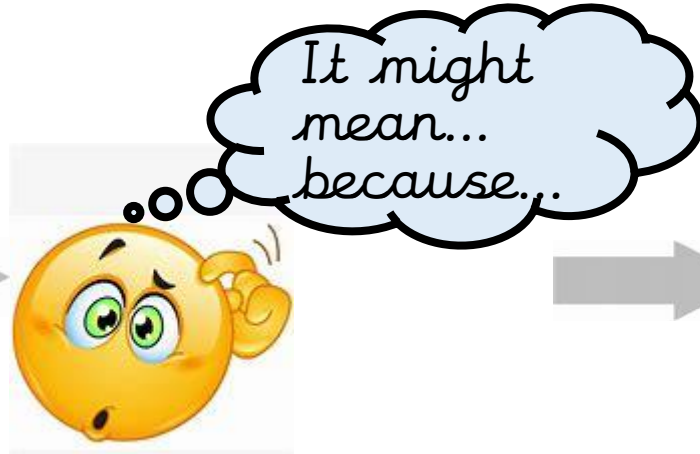

do we know?

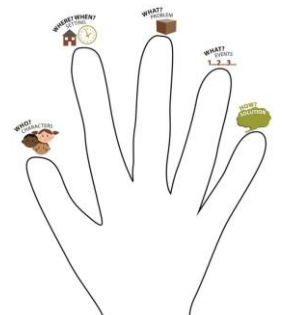

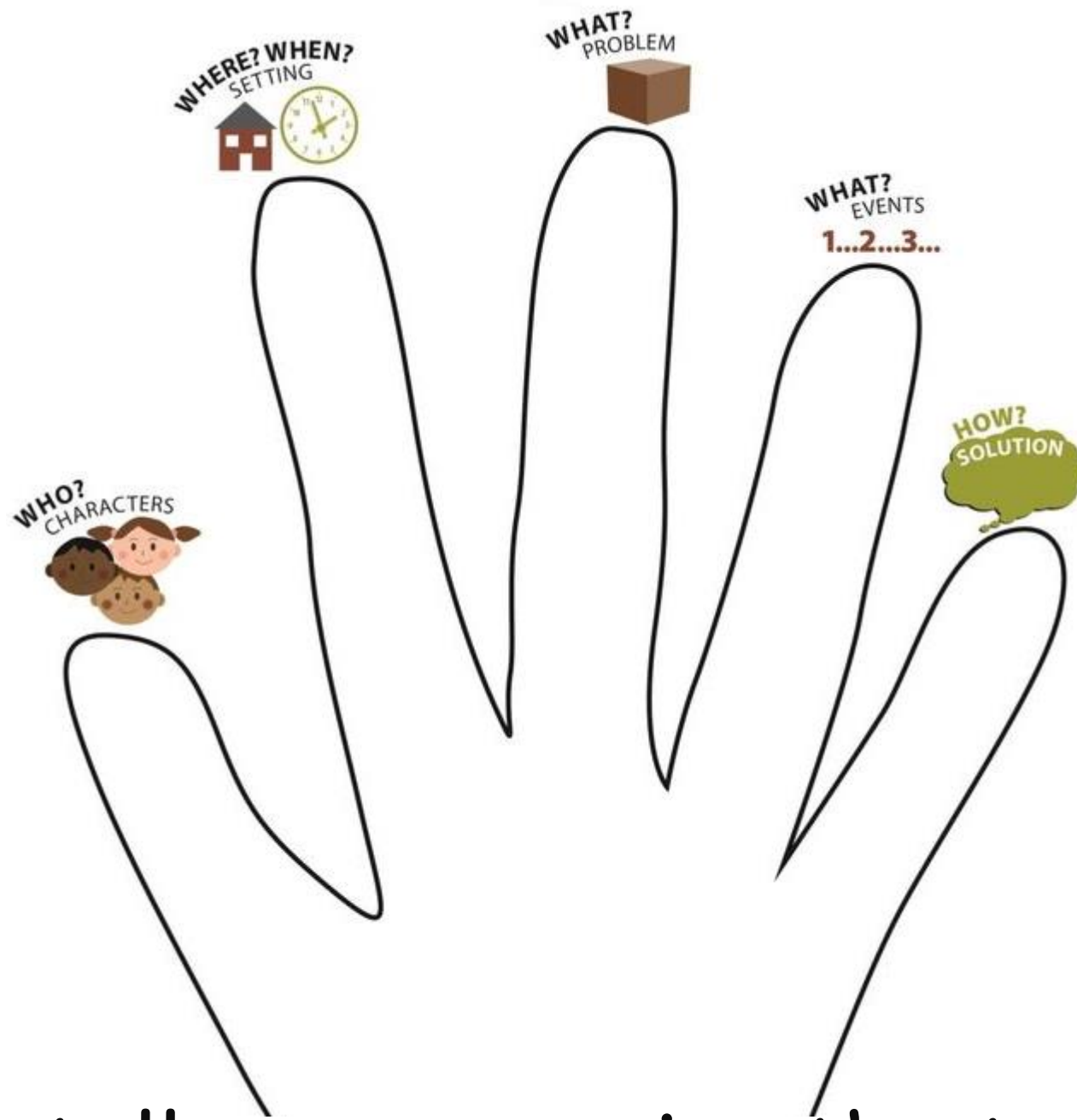
