Response for pupils

Your teachers will use assessment throughout all your lessons (you won't even notice!), when marking your work and when they give you short tests or longer tests to find out how you are doing. They will then provide feedback to you so that you are able to improve your work and help you with the parts you find difficult. Your teachers will support you to be the best learner you can be. By talking to your parents, including at parents' evenings, teachers will keep parents informed about the progress you are making in school and what you need to do, including homework, to ensure that you make the most of your abilities.

Response for parents

Your child's teacher will be available to discuss your child's progress at any time by appointment and, in each term, at parents' evenings. These discussions will be very personal to your child, celebrating his or her strengths and discussing how they can improve and develop further. Your child's teacher will discuss how you can support your child to be the best they can be.

Response for school and local authority

Information about how well our children are progressing is used to develop school-improvement priorities and the staff's professional development. This information is used to compare the success of Stokes Wood Primary School with other schools in the city and the country.
