

#### Woodland Walk:

A reminder that children are not allowed to go up into the woodland walk unaccompanied. This includes Year 5 and 6 children who walk home on their own.

An adult must go up into the walk with children. Everyone must stay on the walk way to avoid slipping. In the winter, the walk way can also be slippery so everyone should walk.

The adult rule is to keep your children safe. Youths from the estate can get over into the woodland walk and sometimes leave rubbish (cans, broken bottles and other things you would not want your child to pick up). Mr Bhana goes up into the walk regularly to clear it of anything but not every day.
