**Hello Parents and Carers of reception children,**

This is a video to help you understand how to read lilac books, that have no words, with your child at home. We will be sending these home with your child next week. We understand that some children can already read however, this is to support your child to find pleasure in reading and help with their comprehension (understanding). Your child will take these home for around two weeks and then they will start to take home a reading book with words. Please make sure that you read the book that your child brings home at least three times a week for around 15 minutes. Please also make sure that your child brings their reading book to school every day.

### **Health and Safety Reminders**

- **Please wheel bikes and scooters on the school grounds (no riding)**
  - **Please do not bring electric scooters onto the school grounds.**
  - **Please do not allow your child to walk or climb on the walls.**
