1) Miss Williams shared Eco Actin Plan

Children commented that they enjoyed the Fuel Poverty Workshops. Mr Smith will look at making some hedgehog houses. Miss Williams will speak to Mrs Wakling about the LEAD award. Mr Smith explained that he has had a quote for PIR sensors in the school, but this was £14000 which is very expensive.

2) Eco Monitors

Discussed that the children need to take an active part in ensuring lights are turned off and doors shut and projectors in the classroom. Miss Williams explained that she has sent out 9 Step Carbon challenge to families and encouraged the Eco Council to take part and remind the class of this.
